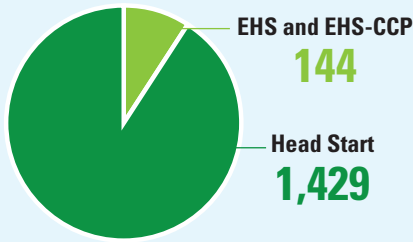
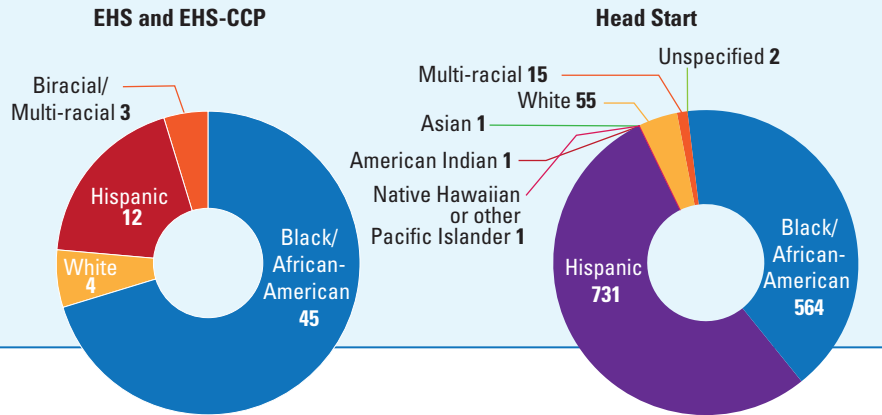


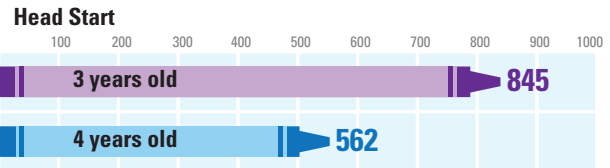
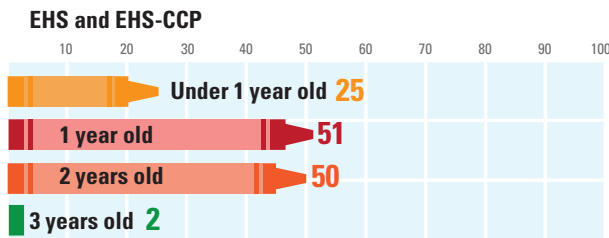
Cumulative Enrollment



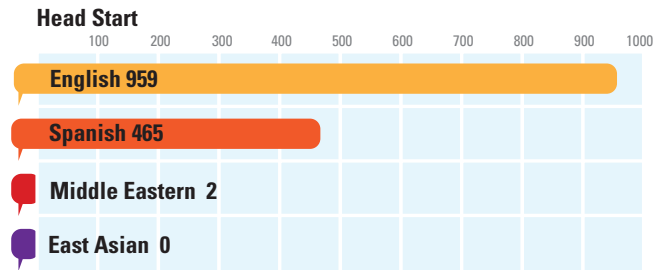
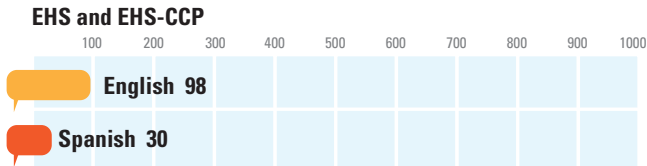

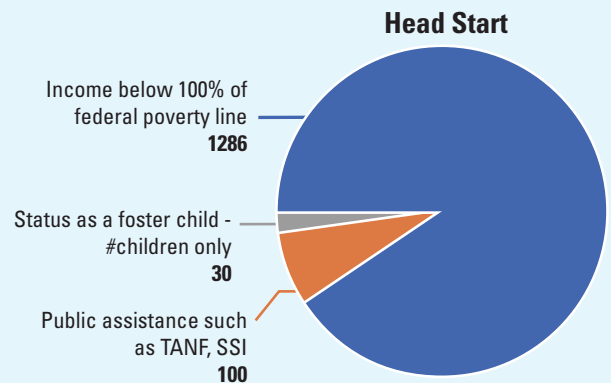
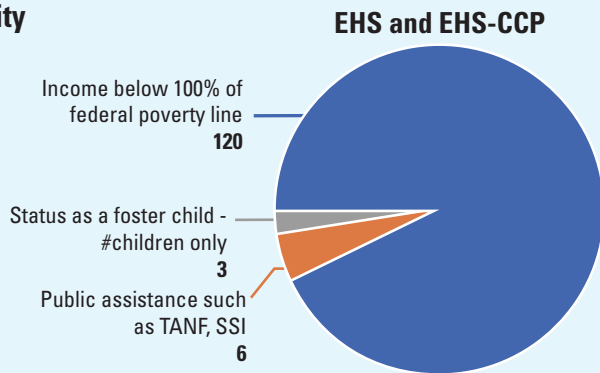
Enrollment by age



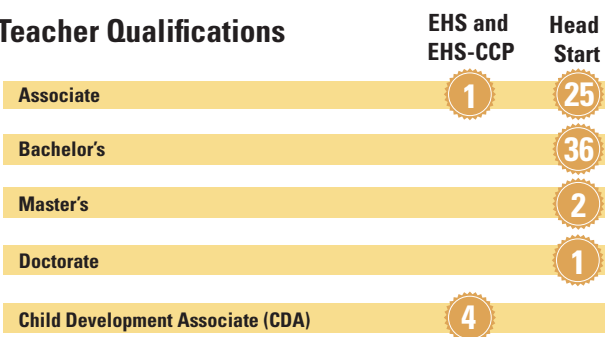

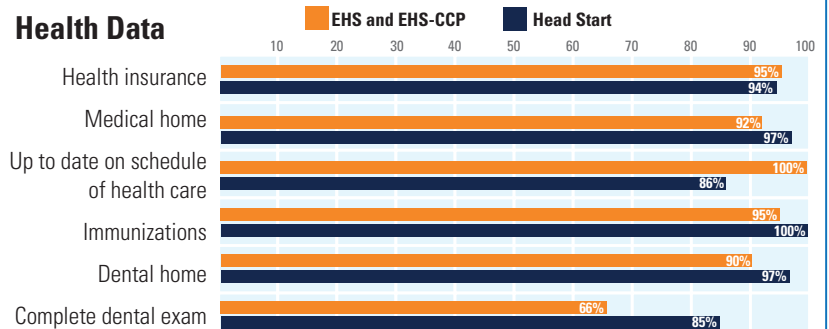

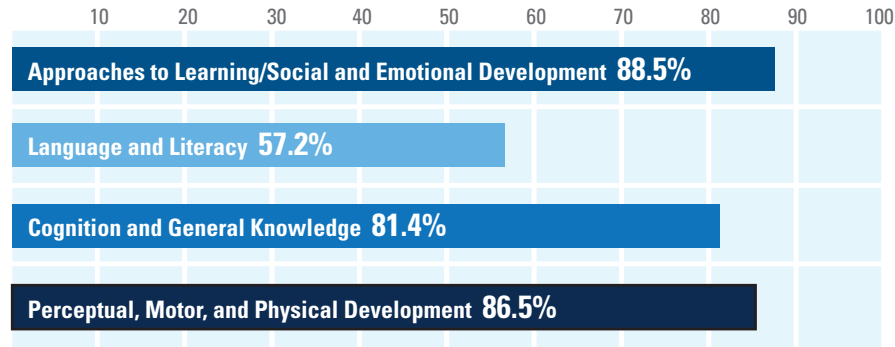

Mid-Year Assessment Results for Four Year Olds



Due to COVID-19, Campuses were closed early. Head Start was unable to collect end-of-year assessment results. As a result, Head Start was unable to fully assess student outcomes; however, mid-year results indicate Head Start was on track to meet at least three out of four domains.

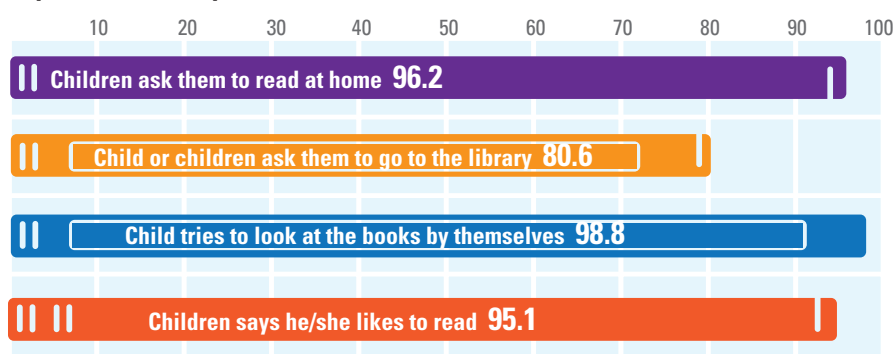
