




Adult Education Enrollment Trends









Delivery Modes








Students Served by Class Location 22-23





Student Performance: Measurable Skills Gains







The New Adult Education Learning Center

- In its first year of operation, the Adult Education Learning Center served 1,684 students in its ESL, GED and vocational classes.
- The New Adult Learning Center hosted 80 educational and community activities including conferences and meetings.
