Center for Safe and Secure Schools - School safety audits, emergency preparedness and threat assessment training, restorative practices programs **65,676**

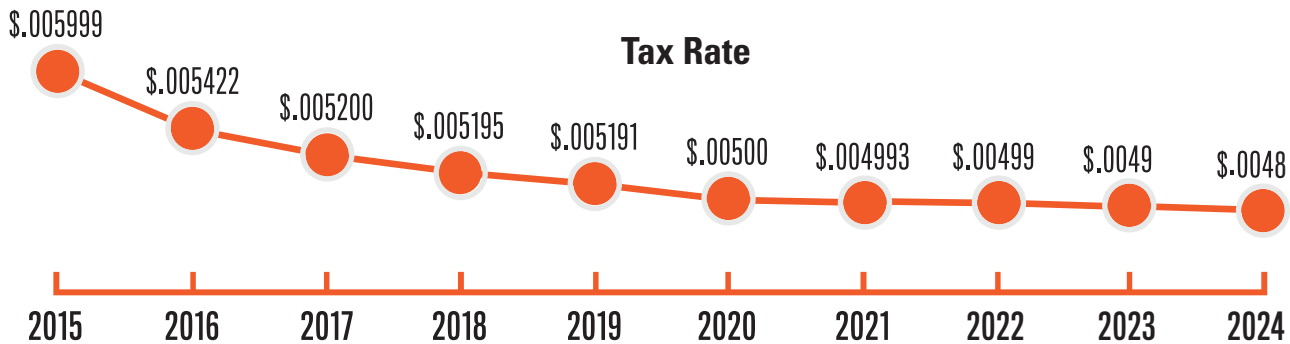

For every local property tax dollar collected, HCDE provides **\$5.68** in services

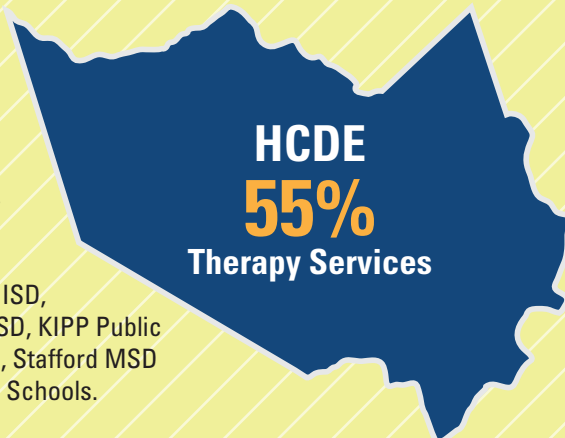
