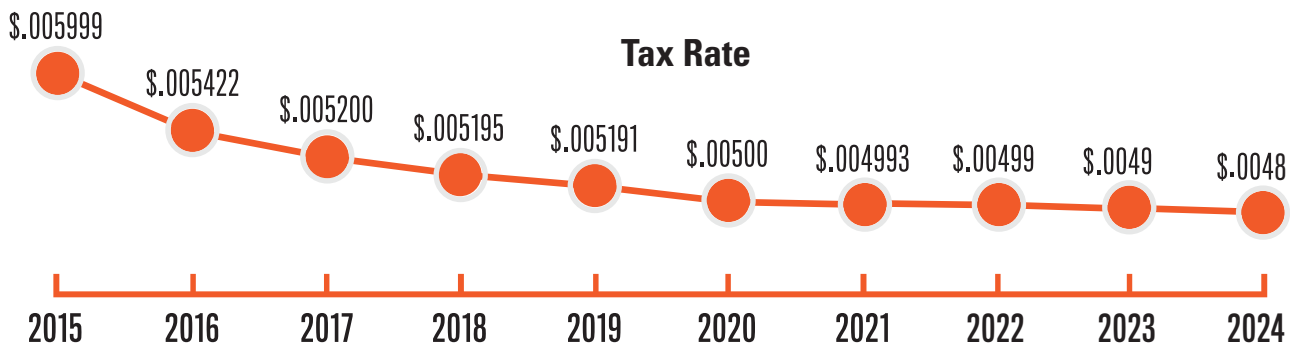

<p><b>CASE for Kids</b> - Afterschool and summer enrichment program support for regional providers, Ecobot tournaments and debate competitions ..... <b>17,985</b></p>	<p><b>Center for Educator Success</b> - Provides professional development and instructional support for educators ..... <b>16,300</b></p>

For every local property tax dollar collected, HCDE provides **\$5.68** in services

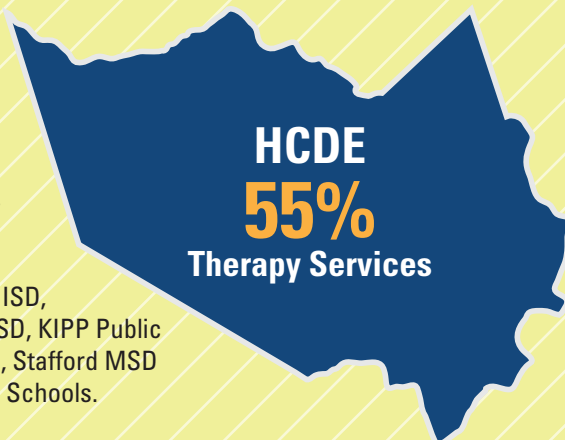
